
Description


Euncet Business School, with the aim of reporting and presenting its results on an annual basis, has prepared the following report detailing the data obtained in the processes listed below:



As can be seen in the teaching hours, the trend shows an increasing progression over time for each of the academic years from 2019 to the present.

The centre has adjusted its teaching staff and teaching load to current regulations with the ultimate aim of complying with the requirements set by these regulations of having a minimum of 50% of PhD professors, among which there are a minimum of 60% accredited professors, all related to the teaching load.

At the same time, as it is essentially a professionalising master's degree, it has been considered appropriate to increase the participation of teaching staff who are experts in the subject and who have a strong professional link with the professional opportunities of the master's degree.
