Campus Euncet Terrassa



Our Terrassa campus is located in a natural area, at the foot of the Parc Natural de Sant Llorenç del Munt i l'Obac, 3 km from Terrassa city centre. This privileged environment is easily accessible and offers a daily bus service and also favors ideal conditions for concentration, intellectual work and study.

FREE BUS SERVICE AT TERRASSA **CAMPUS**

AFFILIATION TO UPC

In 1996, we took a very important step in our history when we signed an agreement with the Universitat Politècnica de Catalunya · BarcelonaTech (UPC), which is globally recognized for its academic excellence. Under this agreement our students obtain a degree from the UPC and can access all the services offered to its educational community. The Universitat Politècnica de Catalunya is a public institution of research and higher education in the fields of engineering, architecture, science and technology, and is one of the leading polytechnic universities in Europe. It graduates more than 6,000 bachelor's and master's degree students and more than 500 PhDs a year. It is one of the universities with the highest rate of job placement of its graduates: 93% are working and 76% find a job in less than 3 months after graduation. In addition, it is also well positioned in the main international rankings.

Mode of study:

ACTIVITIES AND COMPETITIONS





BEFORE ARRIVING AT EUNCET BUSINESS SCHOOL

Residence and NIE



If you are a non-EU (European Union) student, you must apply for the corresponding student visa to come to Spain. You can apply for it at the Spanish embassy or consulate in your country and it usually takes at least three months to complete the process.

If your stay in Spain will last more than 6 months and you have come with a student visa from your country, you will need to obtain your Student Foreigner Identification Card (Tarjeta de Identificación de Extranjero, TIE), which will be the extension of your visa. To do this, you must register in the census of the city where you live, in order to officially indicate that you live there.

Whether you have just applied for a visa or have a TIE, you will be given a Foreigner Identification Number (Número de Identificación de Extranjero, NIE), which is unique and personal. Thanks to the NIE, you will be able to do things like opening a bank account.

Health and medical insurance

INTERNATIONAL INSURANCE



When applying for a student visa, non-EU students are required to get a private health insurance. Once in Spain and depending on the period for which the insurance was taken out in their country, they will have to renew it or take out another private medical insurance once here, which will guarantee the medical assistance while they remain in Spain. Some countries have agreements with the Spanish Social Security that allow to receive free care in all centers, dispensaries of primary care centers (CAP) and hospitals of the Catalan Health Institute. In either case, all students must be privately insured of the following: health care coverage, accident coverage, coverage for the transfer of mortal remains and civil liability. Once they find the right insurance, they will be asked to sign a statement of insurance.

PHARMACIES



If during your stay you need to go to the pharmacy, you should know that they are recognizable by a green luminous cross. If you need to find a pharmacy out of usual opening hours, you can consult the list of the pharmacies on duty outside the door of the closed pharmacies. Most medicines are sold only by medical prescription.

PRIMARY CARE CENTERS AND HOSPITALS




Catalonia has a wide range of health centers and hospitals. The public health system is universally accessible and many health services are free of charge if you have a TSE, in addition to guaranteeing a good quality of health care.

- Primary care centers (Centro de Atención Primaria, CAP): this is the first place you should go to when you have a health problem. In order to access their services free of charge, it is necessary to have a European Health Insurance Card (Tarjeta Sanitaria Europea, TSE).
- Public hospitals: you can only go there in case of emergency. If you have a health problem, you must first go to your referral CAP and they will refer you to a hospital if they think it is necessary. In order to access their services free of charge you must also have a TSE.
- Private medical centers: there are also private hospitals and clinics. If you have a private health insurance, you should consult which hospitals and clinics are covered by your insurance.

Transports

Barcelona and its metropolitan area (where Terrassa is located) have many transport options:

TRAIN

In Catalonia, there are two railroad networks: Renfe and Ferrocarrils de la Generalitat de Catalunya (FGC). These are the most frequented means of transport for students who make the Terrassa-Barcelona route, in both directions. In Renfe, R4 is the one that links the two cities, while in FGC is line S1.

BIKE



More and more citizens use bicycles as a means of transport, because in addition to being environmentally friendly, it saves time. Many cities, such as Terrassa and Barcelona, have bicycle lanes to facilitate coexistence with other vehicles and pedestrians. In addition, in Barcelona you can use Bicing, an extensive public network of public bicycles with different rates.

TRAM



Although in Europe it is a very frequent transport, in Catalonia the tramway has only been implemented in two counties: Baix Llobregat and Barcelonés (where Barcelona is located). There are no trams in Terrassa.

METRO



Along with the railroad, this is the means of public transport with the highest capacity, but most metro lines are in Barcelona city.

TAXI



In all the cities you will find a taxi service, which is identified with different colors. For example, in Barcelona you will identify them by their traditional yellow and black colors, while in Terrassa they are predominantly white. You can find them at the taxi stations, which are close to train stations or relevant buildings, or call directly to the phone number service in each city so they can pick you up wherever you are. All taxis are identified with a blue car number plate. There are other taxi services: Cabify or Uber are examples of them.

BUS



It is the motor public transport par excellence. The bus network is made up of buses that serve municipalities (urban) and those that connect with different localities of Catalonia (interurban). Among all the bus lines, Barcelona has a Nit Bus (night bus service) that covers a large part of the city and the surrounding area.



Accommodation

STUDENT RESIDENCES



A student residence is a place where you will meet people from all over the world. You can rent a room just for yourself or, if you prefer, you can share it with another student. They offer many services, (such as canteen, laundry, among others) and they have common areas, where you can share moments of spare and work with other students.

If this is your option, you can check the residences of the company Resa, which are located in Terrassa and Barcelona. You can also have a look at the residence XIOR Diagonal- Besós, which is located in Barcelona.

SHARE AN APARTAMENT



Usually, university students share an apartment. This type of renting allows you to save money, as they are cheaper, and it also allows you to meet new people and to be able to live with students from different cultures. On the other hand, this housing method is much more flexible in case of change of residence.

You can also take a look at the Living and coexisting program (Vivir y convivir), a solidarity project of the Roure Fundation, which consists of sharing accommodation with an elderly person, who hosts a university student in exchange for his or her company and the agreed personal help, with no financial exchange. It is a social program of mutual help, with a minimum duration of one academic year. In this last case, students must be fluent in Catalan and/or Spanish.

Bank

As long as you reside in Spain, it will be very useful to have a bank account to control your expenses and your income in a safe way (renting an apartment, applying for a grant, receiving money from your country...) and to be able to withdraw money in the ATMs that operate 24 hours a day.

Before leaving your country, we also recommend that you check with your bank to find out about the commissions for using your card abroad and about the conditions for transferring money.

HOW TO OPEN A BANK ACCOUNT

- If you are resident, you need to present your NIE at the bank or financial institution. "See page 13 in this guide".
- If you are a non-resident, you must first obtain a certificate of non-residence. In order to get it, it is necessary to go to your consulate or to any office of the National Police Directorate and, by presenting your passport, you must request the certificate of non-residence (it usually takes

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Passport or national identity card (if you are an EU citizen) which must be valid and must not be expired.
- A document to verify your address in Spain, which can be a recent bank statement or a bill for a service (issued in the last 3 months).
- A document that certifies your current employment status (such as a paycheck, tax return or a government letter confirming your unemployment status or that you are receiving unemployment benefits).

Mobile phone and Internet services

Upon arrival in Spain, it is also advisable to have a cell phone with a Spanish number, as it will be very useful for any kind of daily process.

- Prepaid card: you can purchase a prepaid card in the telephony portals, in the physical stores of the operators and kiosks, among other points of sale.
- Contract: if you need to contract a telephone line or internet, you can do so with the same operators that offer the service and it will be necessary to provide an account number to bill you for the service. You can also get promotional packages of telephone + internet with low-cost flat rates, although they may be subject to retention agreement (usually of at least 1 year).

In Spain, there are different companies with which you can contract the services you need. The most common are Movistar, Vodafone, Orange and Jazztel.
