

## **SPECIFIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Master's Degrees at Euncet Business School



## 1. SPECIFIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students who apply to study the master's degree in English must accredit, at the time of enrolment, a minimum level of English equivalent to B2 in order to gain access to the course.

Accreditation of this level can be obtained by means of:

- Certificates and diplomas from the Catalan Escola Oficial d'idiomes, issued after passing the corresponding tests that assess the four skills (Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking).
- The certificates of the university language schools of all Catalan universities issued after passing the corresponding tests that assess the four skills (Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking). UPC's certificate is a unified model.
- Certificates, qualifications and diplomas with the CertAcles seal issued by the
  universities of the Association of Language Centres in Higher Education (ACLES),
  such as the CLUC (Certificate of Languages of the Universities of Catalonia) tests,
  which are organised by the language services and language schools of Catalan
  universities, and other certificates accepted by ACLES.
- Baccalaureate or equivalent qualifications and university qualifications obtained abroad. These qualifications accredit a C1 level in the language of the education system in the country of origin.
- Baccalaureate or similar qualifications from approved schools in other countries studied in Spain. These qualifications accredit a level C1.
- The certificates and diplomas specified in the <u>Language Certificates Table</u> of the Generalitat de Catalunya. All these certificates are valid indefinitely, unless the certificate itself specifies a period of validity.

Students who have a high level of English, but cannot demonstrate a minimum level of B2 by means of a certificate or diploma, can demonstrate this by means of a level test administered by Euncet's Language Department.
